	In this unit pupils learn to introduce themselves, count up to 30, use the verb “tener” to give their age, say when their birthday is, use definite articles el/la and the indefinite articles un/una.	In this unit pupils learn to talk about school subjects, use the verb “estudiar”, talk about teachers and give opinions and reasons, understand masculine and feminine adjective agreements, talk about lunch break using “comer” and “beber”.	In this unit pupils learn to talk about family and pets, use the possessive adjectives, make colours agree with nouns, talk about appearance and character, use the verb “ser” and count up to 100.	In this unit pupils learn to talk about where people live, describe their homes, use the verbs “vivir” and “estar”, use simple prepositions, talk about their bedrooms and free time activities.	In this unit pupils learn to talk about their hobbies and what they do in their free time, tell the time, use the verb “ir” and the infinitive to talk about the immediate future, give opinions on activities and sports.	In this unit pupils learn to describe their city, build longer sentences using “porque” and “pero”, make and respond to invitations, talk about the weather, use two different tenses together.

	In this unit pupils learn to talk extensively about activities and people, express opinions using “me gusta”, comparing people and things using “más que”, use reflexive verbs and sequencing words.	In this unit pupils learn to talk about places in town using the future tense, invite someone to go out, make excuses using “querer” and “poder”, use phrases with infinitives.	In this unit pupils learn to talk about different countries and languages, talk about holidays using present, future and preterite tenses, express opinions about past events, give a presentation about holidays.	In this unit pupils learn to talk about food and drinks, go shopping for food, use time expressions, understand the difference between “tu” and “usted”, talk about likes and dislikes.	In this unit pupils learn to talk about fashion and clothes, make colour agree, use comparative and superlative adjectives, use past, present and near future tenses together.	In this unit pupils learn to talk about parts of the body, symptoms and illnesses, talk about healthy and unhealthy food, use adverbs of frequency, learn about the Mediterranean diet.

Spanish is studied as an additional language from year 8 onwards.
