St Andrew the Apostle School was first opened in 2013 in partnership with a group of local parents to serve the local community. It began life with Year 7 only in one building on the North London Business Park.

Currently, it is now home to Years 7 to 13 in two temporary, buildings on the Business Park. It is one of five secondary 'Free' schools in the Russell Education Trust; the others are as follows:



- Turing House School – top performer 2022 in Richmond, just moved into a new build.
- King's School – top performer 2022 in Brighton and Hove, just moved into a new build.
- Becket Keys Church of England School – one of the top state funded schools in Essex 2022.
- Bristol Free School – rated 'Good' at last Ofsted where 'Leaders are ambitious for all pupils'
